FINAL DEGREE SCORE

The final degree score is assigned by the Degree Commission and can reach a maximum of 110/110. In presence of candidates reaching the maximum score, the Degree Commission can assign the additional honour "cum laude".

In the case of particularly meritorious theses, the Commission can also propose a "mention".

The final degree score is established on the basis of the following grid:

A) Study career	from 66 to 110 pt	Computed on the basis of single exams scores by the Student Office
B) Master's thesis	from 1 to 5 pt	Degree Commission

C) Graduation within the regular duration of the Master's Course (2 years)	+ 2 pt	Student Office
D) Formation abroad (ERASMUS SMS, ERASMUS TRAINEESHIP, ULISSE, etc.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • up to 3 months = +1 pt • more than 3 months = +2 pt 	Student Office
