

MASTER'S DEGREE IN WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT, CONSERVATION AND CONTROL

PROCEDURE OF ENROLMENT FOR NON-EU STUDENTS

International students from a non-EU country can achieve the enrolment to the Master's Degree in Wildlife Management Conservation and Control in the following five steps (brief list, followed by details):

1. Send preliminary documentation to UNISS and wait for its evaluation
2. Register on University portal for pre-enrolment
3. Apply for an entry visa (permit for study purposes) and contact the Italian Embassy/Consulate in your country to have it
4. Entry test for admission to WMCC
5. Enrollment to WMCC

PRE - ENROLMENT AND VISA FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- 1) Please send the documentation to the University of Sassari, to Dr. M. Rita Cubeddu (email rcubeddu@uniss.it) and to Dr. Elisabetta Soi (email wmcc@uniss.it) in order to verify your entry requirements to the course. Specifically, you have to send: the identity document, the CV, the Secondary School Certificate, the First Degree Level (Bachelor) Certificate, Academic Transcript of Records of the First Degree. Also, if you have it, please send a certificate of knowledge of the English language.
- 2) Once the Secretary staff has checked your documentation and you have received a positive feedback by the office, please register on the [University portal](#) for pre-enrolment.
- 3) Then you can apply for an entry visa for study purposes at the [website](#). The **procedure may vary according to the provisions issued by the individual Italian consulate or embassy abroad** and it is the candidate's responsibility to inquire about specific procedures and deadlines. The procedures for **issuing this visa** must be concluded by the Embassy/Consulate, without prejudice to possible different future instruction, **by 30 November**.

The admission process for non-EU students who require a visa to finalize the enrolment procedures follows the **directives** published annually by the Italian Ministry of University and Research (**MUR**) in collaboration with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (**MAECI**) and the Ministry of the Interior. These guidelines also establish the procedures and deadlines for pre-enrolment with Italian agencies abroad and the application for a study visa. All details and information regarding deadlines are specified in a document which is published every year at [here](#).

N.B. The preliminary acceptance by the University does not confer any right to obtain a visa and it does not imply any right to the subsequent enrolment.

ENROLMENT TO THE WMCC COURSE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SASSARI

- 4) For final admission to the course you have to pass an entry test to the course concerning English language and five basic disciplines (zoology, genetics, ecology, anatomy/physiology and microbiology). The test will be held online and upcoming dates will be communicated to you by email. More information is given at www.uniss.it/wildlife.
- 5) Finally you can enroll to the University of Sassari through the portal SelfStudenti <https://uniss.esse3.cineca.it> **starting from 1 August** (until 15 January).

Classes start at the beginning of October.
